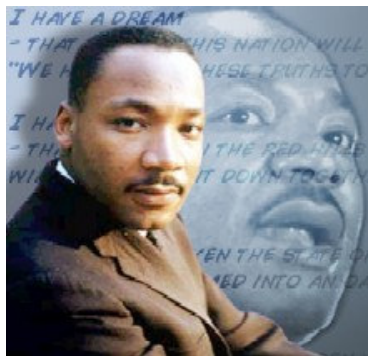
Our theme this year is *"A Renewed Hope for Peace; Building Stronger Communities."*
